

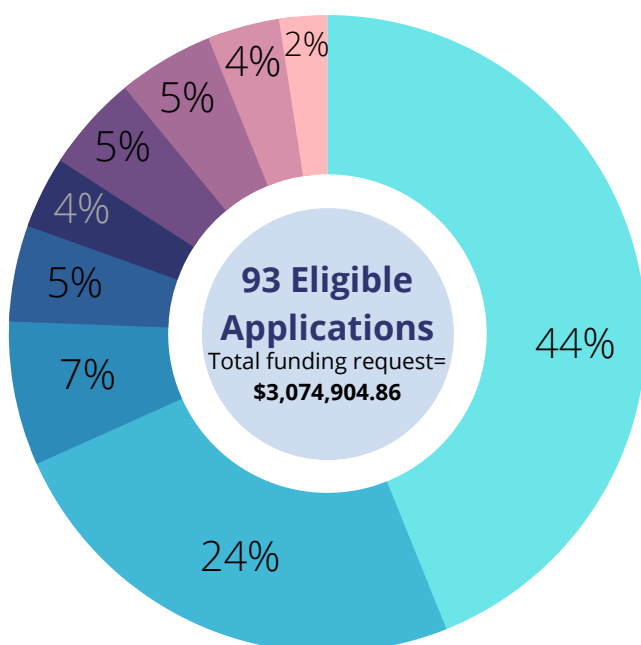

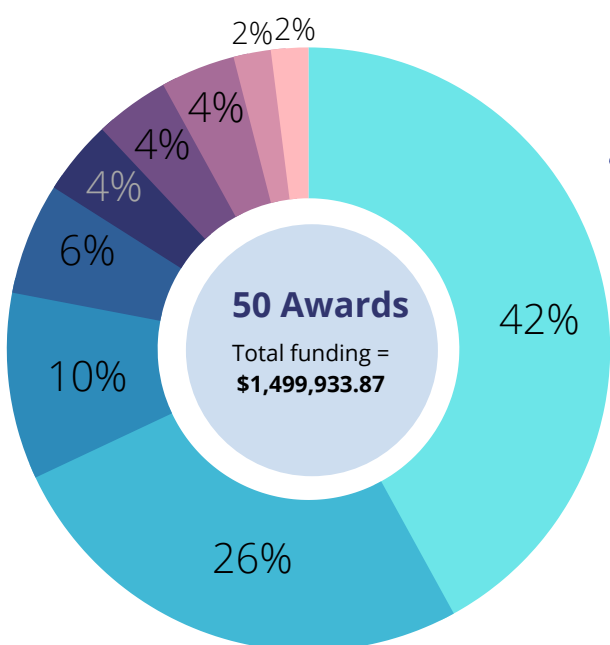

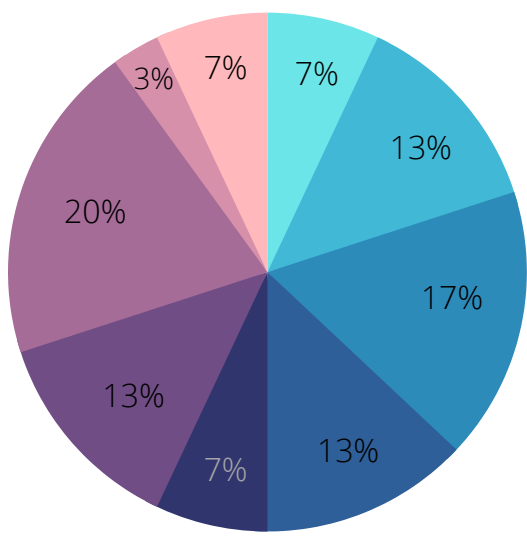

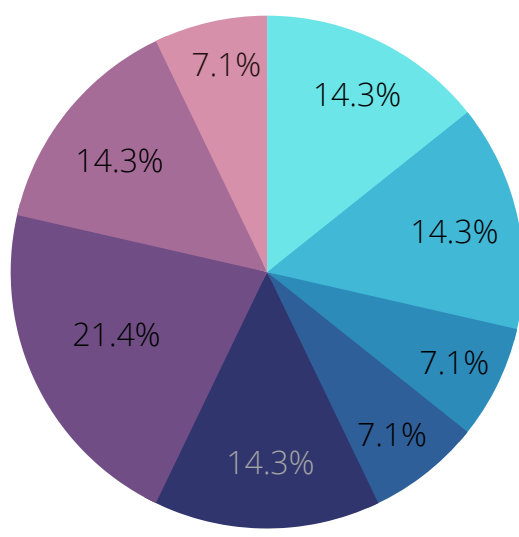

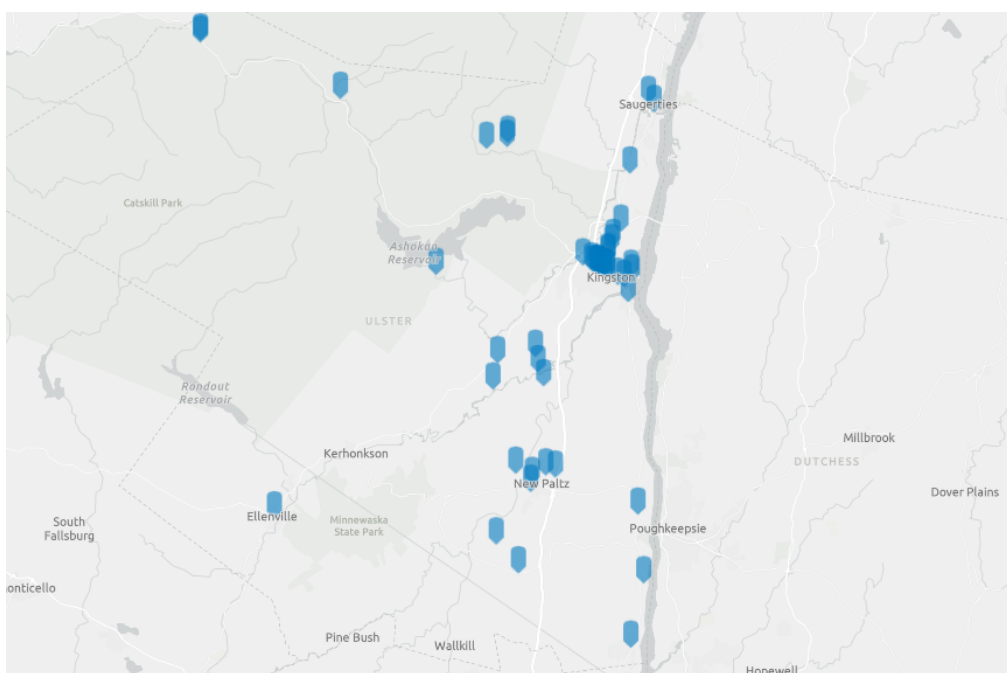
### Resilience Funded Projects by Category
